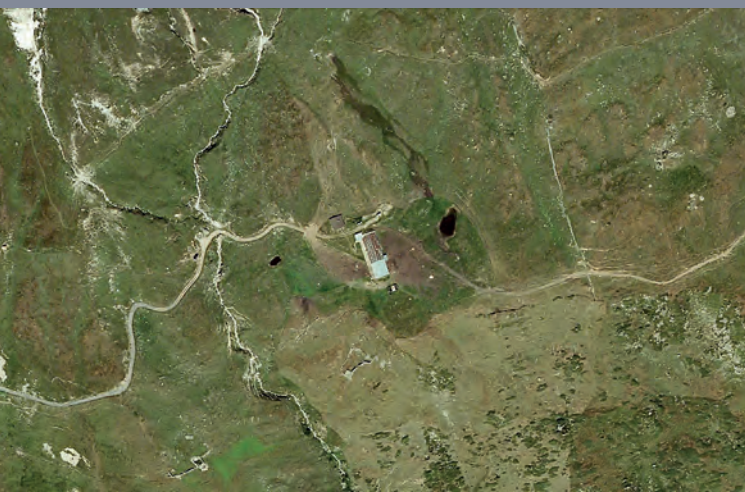
for Alpine Archaeology
